STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to provide for the proper expenditure by towns of school money received from the state.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

When the governor and council have reason to believe 2 that any town has neglected to raise and expend the 3 school money required by law, or to faithfully expend 4 the school money received from the state, it shall be 5 their duty to direct the state treasurer to withhold 6 further payments to such town from the state treasury 7 on account of the state school fund and mill tax, until 8 such town shall satisfy them that it has expended the 9 full amount required by law for common school 10 purposes.
