STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls.

Resolved, That the action of the officers of the Maine 2 Industrial School for Girls, in accepting the offers of 3 two benevolent ladies of Hallowell for the endowment 4 of said school, and in locating said school in said 5 Hallowell, are hereby approved; and whenever the 6 officers of said school shall secure the sum of twenty 7 thousand dollars by donations of real and personal 8 estate, and responsible subscriptions of money, includ-9 ing the offers already made, and exhibit satisfactory 10 evidence thereof to the governor and council, the 11 governor, by the advice and consent of the council, is 12 hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the state 13 treasurer for the amount of five thousand dollars in 14 favor of the trustees of said school, to be expended by
