IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-two, section thirtynine of the revised statutes, relating to fees of fence viewers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter twenty-two, section thirty-nine of the

- 2 revised statutes be amended as follows, after the words
- 3 employing him, "at the rate of one dollar a day"
- 4 insert 'at the rate of two dollars per day,' so that
- 5 said section as amended shall read as follows:
- 6 Each fence viewer shall be paid by the person em-
- 7 ploying him at the rate of two dollars per day for the
- 8 time he is so employed. If the party liable neglects
- 9 to pay the same for thirty days after demand, each of
- 10 said fence viewers may recover double the amount in

- 11 an action on the case, and be mutually witnesses for
- 12 or against each other.
