STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend item five of section fifty-five of chapter eleven of the revised statutes, relating to school registers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Amend section fifty-five, item fifth, (School Laws) 2 by appending the following, “and also the total number of different scholars attending school two weeks or 3 more of the preceding year as shall appear from the 4 school registers returnable to said officers agreeably to 5 section sixty-three, chapter eleven, of the revised 6 statutes;” so that item fifth, section fifty-five shall 7 read as follows : 8

9 *Fifth*—The whole number and the average number 10 of scholars attending the summer schools ; the whole 11 number and the average number of scholars attending

12 the winter schools, and also the total number of differ-
13 ent scholars attending school two weeks or more of the
14 preceding year as shall appear from the school
15 registers returnable to said officers agreeably to section
16 sixty-three, chapter eleven of the revised statutes.
