STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend "an act additional to an act to incorporate the Calais Railway Company, and the several acts additional thereto."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section four of said act is hereby amended

- 2 by striking out the words, "by their by-laws," and
- 3 adding to said section the following words: "Said
- 4 lien shall continue upon lumber of all descriptions, so
- 5 long as said lumber, or any part thereof, shall remain
- 6 upon the wharf or at the place where landed, and
- 7 may be enforced by suit and attachment, as in case of
- 8 liens on logs and lumber, as well as in the manner
- 9 above described," so that said section, as amended,
- 10 shall read:

11 For any services said company may per-12 form they may demand and collect such toll or com-13 pensation as they shall determine, and collect it in 14 advance or otherwise; and in addition to these other 15 remedies therefor, shall have a lien on all the property 16 concerning or in reference to which said service may 17 have been rendered, for said toll or compensation; 18 which if said compensation be delayed for ten days, 19 they may make available by sale thereof at auction, 20 on posting seven days notice thereof before the sale in 21 the town where the property is landed, stating the 22 amount claimed, for what, the place, day and hour of 23 sale, and substantially a description of the property 24 to be sold, as near as can conveniently be done. 25 lien shall continue upon lumber of all descriptions, so 26 long as said lumber, or any part thereof, shall remain 27 upon the wharf or at the place where landed, and may 28 be enforced by suit and attachment, as in case of liens 29 on logs and lumber, as well as in the manner above 30 described.
