RESOLVE concerning the Pilgrim Society at Plymouth,  
Massachusetts.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of three thousand dollars be,  
2 and hereby is, appropriated for the purpose of con-  
3 tributing an alto-relief, in Maine granite, of the  
4 “ Signing of the Social Compact ” in the cabin of the  
5 Mayflower, to be placed, as designed, in one of the  
6 panels of the national monument which the Pilgrim  
7 Society is erecting at Plymouth, to the memory of the  
8 forefathers of this commonwealth. And his excellency,  
9 the governor, is hereby authorized, with the advice  
10 and consent of the council, to draw his warrant there-  
11 for, payable to the authorized agent of said society,  
12 in such sums, and at such times, as may seem expe-  
13 dient, in proportion to the whole work.
