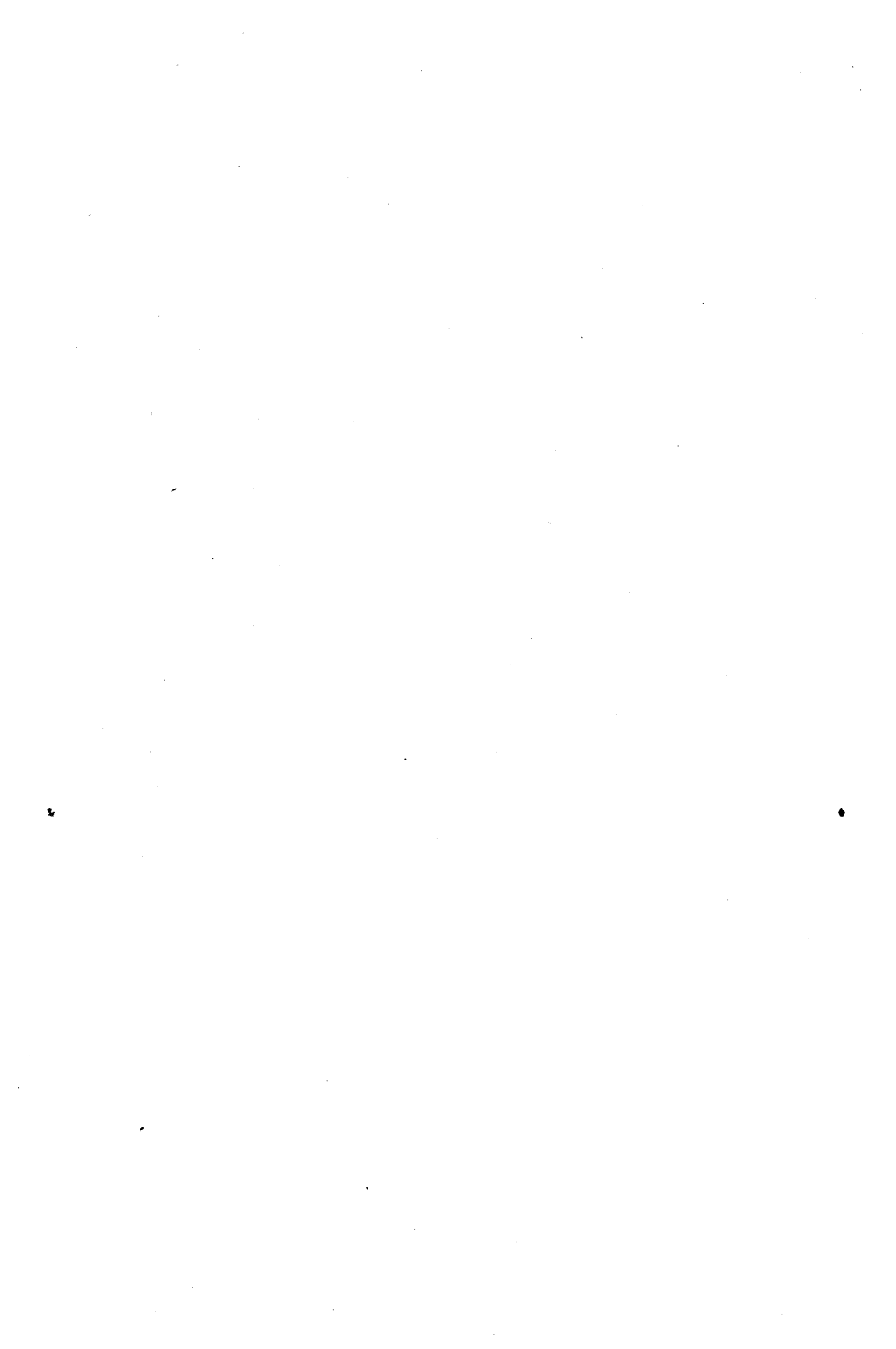
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to exempt cemetery lots from attachment.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. That lots in public or private cemeteries
2 are exempt from attachment and levy on execution,
3 and from liability to be sold by executors and admin-
4 istrators of insolvent estates, for the payment of debts
5 and charges of administration. But there shall not
6 be so exempt for any one person more than one lot.

SECT. 2. This act takes effect from its approval.
