## STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. In order to provide for the several acts 2 and resolves of the legislature requiring the payment 3 of money from the treasury, and also to provide for 4 the necessary expenditures of government for the cur-5 rent fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appro-6 priated out of any moneys in the treasury, and the 7 governor with the advice and consent of the council, is 8 hereby authorized at any time prior to the first day of 9 January next, to draw his warrant upon the treasury 10 for the same.
