## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter seventeen of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy two, relating to the appointment of deputy town clerks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter seventeen of the 2 public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, is 3 hereby amended by adding thereto, after the word 4 "clerk" in the fourth line, the following words: 5 'And in case of the absence, death, resignation, or 6 removal from office, of the clerk without having made 7 such appointment, the municipal officers of any city, 8 town, or plantation, may appoint a person, who is a 9 citizen as aforesaid, to fill said office, who may per-10 form all the duties of the clerk during his absence,

11 and in case of the clerk's death, resignation, or re-12 moval from office, till a clerk shall be elected.' Also 13 by striking out all after the word "follows" in the 14 fifth line, and substituting the words: 'I (or we) 15 hereby appoint to perform the duties of 16 town clerk, in the town of during the 17 clerk's absence from his office (or till a clerk shall be 18 elected.) clerk (or municipal officers) of 19 the town of Said deputy, or person 20 appointed by the municipal officers, shall be sworn to 21 faithfully perform the duties of his office before he 22 enters thereon.' So that said section, as amended, 23 shall read as follows:

<sup>24</sup> 'Sect. 1. The clerk of any city, town, or planta-<sup>25</sup> tion, in this state, may appoint a citizen of said city, <sup>26</sup> town, or plantation, his deputy, who may, in the <sup>27</sup> clerk's absence, perform all the duties of said office <sup>28</sup> with the same effect as if done by the clerk; and in <sup>29</sup> case of the absence, death, resignation, or removal <sup>30</sup> from office, of the clerk without having made such <sup>31</sup> appointment, the municipal officers of any city town, <sup>32</sup> or plantation, may appoint a person, who is a citizen <sup>33</sup> as aforesaid, to fill said office, who may perform all the <sup>34</sup> duties of the clerk during his absence, and in case of <sup>35</sup> his death, resignation, or removal from office, till a <sup>36</sup> clerk shall be elected. The appointment may be made

37 in writing, as follows: I (or we) hereby appoint
38 to perform the duties of town clerk, in
39 the town of , during the clerk's absence
40 from his office (or till a clerk shall be elected.)
41 , clerk (or municipal officers) of the town of
42 . Said deputy, or person appointed by
43 the municipal officers, shall be sworn to faithfully per44 form the duties of his office, before he enters thereon.
SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
