STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-six of the revised statutes relative to trustee process.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The sixth specification of section fifty-
2 five of chapter eighty-six of the revised statutes, is
3 amended by striking therefrom the words "and this
4 shall not be exempt in any suit for necessaries fur-
5 nished him or his family," so that said specification,
6 as amended, shall read as follows :

7 "Sixth. By reason of any amount due from him
8 to the principal dependent as wages for his personal
9 labor, or that of his wife or minor children, for a
10 time not exceeding one month next preceding the
11 service of the process ; and not exceeding twenty

12 dollars of the amount due to him as wages for his
13 personal labor.”

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
