## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-seven of chapter two of the revised statutes, for the further security of the sinking funds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section fifty-seven of the said chapter is 2 hereby amended by striking out from the second line 3 thereof the word "may" and inserting in its place 4 the word "shall," and by adding after the word 5 "treasurer" in the third line thereof the words "and 6 no registered bond of this state belonging to either of 7 the said sinking funds shall be negotiated by the treas-8 urer unless the governor's assent to the transfer shall 9 be first endorsed thereon, and all such bonds shalls 10 exhibit upon their face this restriction of their negoti-

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11 ability," so that the said section as amended shall 12 read:

13 "Sect. 57. All coupon bonds issued by this state 14 belonging to either of the sinking funds of this state, 15 shall be converted into bonds registered in the name 16 of the treasurer, and no registered bond of this state 17 belonging to either of the sinking funds shall be nego-18 tiated by the treasurer unless the governor's assent to 19 the transfer shall be first endorsed thereon, and all 20 such bonds shall exhibit upon their face this restriction 21 of their negotiability; and any coupon bonds so issued 22 and held by or deposited with the treasurer for trust 3 purposes may be converted into the registered form of 24 bonds hereby authorized, whenever the parties deposit-25 ing them shall desire it."

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
