STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT regulating the weight of apples.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The standard weight of a bushel of apples
2 in good order and fit for market shall be forty-four
3 pounds ; and the measure of this article shall be deter-
4 mined as aforesaid at the request of the vender or
5 vendee, and if either party refuses so to do he shall
6 forfeit twenty cents for each bushel to the person
7 prosecuting therefor within thirty days.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
