IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend chapter eleven, section seven of the revised statutes, relating to the apportionment of school moneys.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Chapter eleven, section seven, of the revised statutes, 2 is hereby amended, by inserting in the fourth line, in 3 said section, after the word "section," in said line, 4 the words 'and all moneys received from the state for 5 school purposes, except the money received under the 6 free high school bill,' so that said section, as amended, 7 shall read as follows :

8 "Sect. 7. The assessors and superintending school  
9 committees, or supervisors of towns, cities and plan-  
10 tations, shall have the power, and may annually ap-

11 portion ten per cent. of all the money required to be  
12 raised, by the fifth section, and ten per centum of all  
13 moneys received from the state for schools, except the  
14 money received under the free high school bill, among  
15 the districts of their several towns, cities and planta-  
16 tions, in such manner as in their judgment, shall give  
17 to the smaller districts, as nearly as may be, an  
18 equal opportunity of enjoying the benefits of common  
19 school education with the larger districts.”
