IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT additional to chapter one hundred and twenty-four of the revised statutes, relating to morality and decency.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Whoever shall deface the walls, benches, seats, 2 blackboards, or other parts of any school house or out- 3 buildings belonging thereto, by making thereon ob- 4 scene pictures, marks, or descriptions, or by writing 5 obscene language, shall be punished by fine not ex- 6 ceeding ten dollars, and municipal and police courts 7 and trial justices shall have jurisdiction thereof on 8 complaint made within one year after the commission 9 of the offence.
