IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT authorizing the Somerset and Kennebec Railroad
company to change its location below Kendall's Mills.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The Somerset and Kennebec Railroad
2 company is hereby authorized to locate, construct and
3 maintain a track or tracks of its railroad outside of its
4 present location between Kendall's Mills in Fairfield
5 and Winslow village, in such place as shall be found
6 by said company to be most suitable and convenient,
7 and to construct and maintain a bridge across the Ken-
8 nebec river, if it shall be found desirable so to do.
9 And said company may discontinue operating such
10 part of its old line of railroad as shall be rendered

11 unnecessary by the construction and operating of the
12 tracks hereby authorized.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its approval.
