IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT exempting farm product from taxation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Hay, grain, and potatoes, orchard pro-
2 ducts, and wool, owned by, and in possession of the
3 producer, shall be exempted from taxation.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
