STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter eighty-three
of the revised statutes, concerning writs issued by trial
justices, and police and municipal courts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter eighty-three of
2 the revised statutes, is hereby amended, by adding
3 thereto the following words, ' and in like manner, and
4 with like effect, original writs, issued by police or
5 municipal courts, may be made returnable before any
6 other police or municipal court, in the same, or an ad-
7 joining county,' so that said section, as amended, shall
8 read as follows :

9 *Sect. 9.* Original writs, issued by any trial justice,
10 may be made returnable before any other trial justice

11 of the same county, and shall have the same effect as
12 if signed by the latter justice, and in like manner,
13 and with like effect, original writs, issued by any
14 police or municipal court, may be made returnable be-
15 fore any other police or municipal court, in the same,
16 or an adjoining county.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
