STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section one, chapter one hundred and eighty-eight of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-one, relating to ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The first section of chapter one hundred and eighty-
2 eight of the public laws of eighteen hundred and
3 seventy-one, are hereby amended, by striking out of
4 said section, in third line, the words "at their first,"
5 and in the fourth line the words "regular terms there-
6 after," so that said section, as amended, shall read :

7 "When a petition for increase of damages, provid-
8 ed by section twenty-five of chapter eighteen of the
9 revised statutes, is presented to the county commis-
10 sioners, they shall order a notice to the town interested

11 in such petition, to appear at the next regular term,
12 and the case shall stand continued, and no jury shall
13 be summoned until all parties interested have been
14 notified and had an opportunity to be present and en-
15 ter into an agreement for a committee, as provided by
16 section eight of the same chapter.”
