STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT for the better security of voluntary trusts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person placing property for any 2 purpose in the hands of a trustee, may, on petition to 3 the judge of probate in the county where he resides, 4 have the appointment of trustee confirmed by said 5 judge; and said trustee shall file a bond, with sure-6 ties, to be approved by said judge, for the fulfilment 7 of said trust, according to the terms and conditions of 8 the trust deed or declaration.

SECT. 2. Such trustee shall be held to account to 2 the judge of probate in the same manner as testamen-3 tary trustees, unless excused or released therefrom by 4 the person creating the trust or for whose henefit the 5 trust was created; and at the termination of such

6 trust, the money or property held by the trustee, shall7 be paid or delivered to the person legally entitled8 thereto.

SECT. 3. If said trustee at any time fails to fulfil the 2 conditions of the trust or of his bond, the parties inter-3 ested shall have the same remedies, and like proceed-4 ings shall be had, as are provided in case of other 5 probate bonds.
