STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-five, chapter forty-nine of
the revised statutes, relating to foreign insurance
companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

That section fifty-five, chapter forty-nine of the re-
2 vised statutes, shall be amended, by adding thereto
3 the following words: "and any such insurance com-
4 pany which shall neglect or refuse to publish such
5 statement, shall forfeit not less than fifty dollars," so
6 that section fifty-five, as amended, shall read as fol-
7 lows :

8 "Every foreign insurance company doing business
9 in this state, shall annually cause to be published,
10 three weeks successively, in some daily or weekly

11 paper, printed in the county where said company
12 has a duly authorized agent or takes policies, a con-
13 densed statement of its condition, conformable to its
14 last annual report to the commissioner ; and any such
15 insurance company which shall neglect or refuse to
16 publish such statement, shall forfeit not less than fifty
17 dollars.”
