AN ACT relating to ways across railroads.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Town ways and highways may be laid out across,  
2 over, or under any railroad track, in the manner pro-  
3 vided by law for laying out such ways; and the ex-  
4 pense of building and maintaining so much of such  
5 way, so laid out, as is within the limits of such rail-  
6 road, shall be borne by the railroad company whose  
7 track is so crossed.
