STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for additional accommodations for the insane.

Resolved, That the governor be and hereby is author-2 ized and directed, with the advice of the council, to 3 appoint a commissioner, whose duty it shall be, as soon 4 as may be, to cause a new hospital to be constructed 5 on the hospital grounds now belonging to the state, or 6 elsewhere, as they shall deem best, in accordance with 7 the pavillion plan recommended in the majority report 8 of the commissioners on "a new insane hospital," ap-9 pointed under a resolve approved February twenty-10 seventh, eighteen hundred and seventy-three.

Resolved, That the doings of the said commissioner 2 shall be under the direction of the governor and coun-3 cil, who shall fix his compensation, and audit all dis-4 bursements under this resolve, and draw their warrant 5 on the treasurer for all amounts due, and the sum of

6 one hundred thousand dollars is hereby appropriated 7 therefor.

Resolved, That the governor and council be and hereby 2 are authorized, if deemed by them expedient, to fit up 3 the hospital brick chapel for the accommodation of such 4 hospital patients as may be advantageously treated 5 therein, and a sum not exceeding five thousand dol-6 lars is hereby appropriated for that purpose.
