STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and sixty-seven of chapter six of the revised statutes relating to the collection of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one hundred and sixty-seven of chapter six

- 2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking
- 3 out the word "four" in the third line and inserting the
- 4 word "three" in place thereof, so that the section as
- 5 amended shall read as follows:
- 6 Sect. 167. For all taxes legally assessed on real
- 7 estate belonging to resident proprietors and on equita-
- 8 ble interests assessed under section three of this chap-
- 9 ter, a lein is hereby created which shall continue in
- 10 force until the payment thereof. If any such tax re-

11 mains unpaid for the term of nine months from the 12 date of the assessment, the collector may give notice 13 thereof, and of his intention to sell so much of such 14 real estate or interest as is necessary for the payment 15 of said tax and all charges, by posting notices thereof 16 in the same manner and at the same places that war-17 rants for town meetings are therein required to be 18 posted, six weeks before the day of sale, designating 19 the name of the owner, if known, the right lot and 20 range, the number of acres as near as may be, the 21 amount of tax due and unpaid, and such other short 22 description as is necessary to render it certain and 23 plain; and shall lodge with the town clerk a copy of 24 such notice, with his certificate thereon, that he has 25 given notice of the intended sale as required by law. 26 Such copy and certificate thereon shall be recorded by 27 said clerk, and the record so made shall be open to the 28 inspection of all persons interested. It shall be the 29 duty of the clerk to furnish to any person desiring it 30 an attested copy of such record, on receiving payment 31 or tender of payment of a reasonable sum therefor.
