## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT respecting school district number seven, in the town of Westbrook.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The vote of the inhabitants of the
- 2 town of Westbrook, passed March third, in the year
- 3 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-
- 4 three, abolishing all school districts in said town of
- 5 Westbrook, is hereby confirmed, and so much of
- 6 school district number seven, in said Westbrook, which
- 7 lies within the limits of the town of Deering, is here-
- 8 by constituted a separate school district, within said
- 9 town of Deering, to be known as school district num-
- 10 ber seven, in said town of Deering, and the said dis-
- 11 trict so formed shall have and enjoy all the powers and

- 12 privileges, and be subject to all the duties belonging
- 13 to school districts under the law of this state.
  - Sect. 2. The treasurer of the town of Westbrook
  - 2 is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the agent
  - 3 of said school district number seven, in the town of
  - 4 Deering, when such officer shall be appointed, its pro-
  - 5 portional part of the appraised value of school dis-
  - 6 trict property in said school district number seven in
  - 7 the town of Westbrook, which was raised by taxation
  - 8 upon the inhabitants of the town of Westbrook in
  - 9 pursuance of the vote aforesaid in the year eighteen
- 10 hundred and seventy-three, and is now remaining in
- 11 the treasury of said town of Westbrook unused. Said
- 12 proportional part to be determined by the amount of
- 13 taxes paid by the portions of said school district num-
- 14 ber seven, lying respectively within the towns of
- 15 Deering and Westbrook.
  - SECT. 3. Said proportional part, when paid to the
  - 2 agent of said school district number seven in the town
  - 3 of Deering, shall be by him applied to the erection of
  - 4 a school house within said district, in accordance with
  - 5 the provisions of law.
  - Sect. 4. The inhabitants of the town of Deering
- 2 are hereby authorized, if they shall elect so to do, to
- 3 pay all reasonable and proper expenses incurred by

- 4 the inhabitants of said school district number seven
- 5 in obtaining the passage of this act.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect on and after its 2 approval by the governor.
