## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

---

---

AN ACT additional to chapter one hundred and thirty-three of the laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, relating to the jail system of the state.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

In addition to the sentence provided for in chapter 2 one hundred and thirty-three of the laws of eighteen 3 hundred and seventy-three, the court or justice may 4 sentence any person to the other punishment provided 5 by law for the same offense. If any person is sen- 6 tenced to imprisonment and labor in either of the jails 7 where the improvement and provision for labor has 8 been made, as provided by said chapter, said sentence 9 shall be conditional that if the person so sentenced 10 cannot be received at the jail to which he is sentenced, 11 or if at any time before the expiration of said sentence

12 he shall in the judgment of the inspectors named in  
13 section nine of said chapter, become incorrigible, or  
14 unsafe, they may order that he suffer such alternative  
15 sentence or punishment; and if said alternate sen-  
16 tence be in the state prison, the sheriff of the county  
17 where such person is imprisoned, shall forthwith, upon  
18 receiving the order of said inspectors, convey or cause  
19 to be conveyed said person to the state prison at the  
20 expense of the county from which such person was  
21 sentenced.
