STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT further to extend the powers of school districts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section twenty-four of chapter eleven of the revised

- 2 statutes, is hereby amended, by adding after the sixth
- 3 item in said section, the following words:
- 4 Seventh.—Any school district, maintaining graded
- 5 schools, by a major vote of those present, at any legal
- 6 meeting, legally warned, may transfer the scholars of
- 7 any grade in such district, to any academy, or private
- 8 or corporate school, and may pay the money which
- 9 would be appropriated to the grade of school so trans-
- 10 ferred, to such academy, or corporate or private school,
- 11 for the tuition of the scholars so transferred; provided,
- 12 that the superintending school committee of the town

- 13 in which such district is situated, shall have the same
- 14 control over such scholars, so transferred, as to stud-
- 15 ies, text-books, classification and discipline.
