STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT explanatory of, and additional to chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes, relating to intoxicating liquors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. It is hereby declared to be the intent
2 and meaning of chapter twenty-seven of the revised
3 statutes of eighteen hundred and seventy-one, relating
4 to intoxicating liquors, that the offences therein
5 described, shall fall within the provisions of section
6 fourteen of chapter one hundred and thirty-one of said
7 revised statutes, and that none of such offences shall
8 be barred by any period of time less than six years
9 after the commission thereof.

SECT. 2. No portion of time during which the
2 offender is not usually and publicly resident in this
3 state, shall be a part of said six years.
