STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of deputy clerk
of courts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The governor, by and with the advice
2 and consent of the executive council, is hereby author-
3 ized, when necessary, to appoint a deputy clerk of
4 courts in the several counties in the state, with the
5 same powers, duties and obligations of the clerk of
6 courts for the same county in which such deputy may
7 be appointed.

SECT. 2. All the acts, signatures and doings of such
2 deputy clerk, shall have the same effect as similar acts
3 of the clerk.

SECT. 3. Any deputy may act during the absence

2 or inability from any cause of the clerk to perform the
3 duties of his office.

SECT. 4. Any deputy thus appointed shall, before
2 entering upon his duties, file a bond in like manner
3 as the clerk for said county.
