STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and fifty-one of
the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight,
relating to the superior court of Cumberland county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Whenever, by accident or mistake, the plaintiff fails
2 to endorse upon his writ at the time of entry a request
3 for a jury trial, or if the defendant, by accident or
4 mistake, shall fail to endorse upon his plea when filed
6 a demand for a jury, the court may, on motion of
7 either party, at its discretion, order a trial by jury in
8 the cause.
