STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend chapter forty-four of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, relating to lands in unincorporated places.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The first section of chapter forty-four of the public

- 2 laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-two is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out, in the second line thereof,
- 4 the words "of section forty-six," and by inserting in
- 5 the third line thereof, after the word "statutes," the
- 6 words, 'of eighteen hundred and fifty-seven and eight-
- 7 een hundred and seventy-one,' and by inserting, after
- 8 the word "state" in the fourth line, the words or
- 9 county,' also by inserting, after the word "state" in

- 10 the eighth and eighteenth lines thereof, the words 'or
- 11 county.'
- 12 The second section of said act is hereby amended by
- 13 striking out, in the second line, the words "of section
- 14 forty-six," and by inserting after the word "statutes"
- 15 in the third line thereof, the words 'of eighteen hun-
- 16 dred and fifty-seven and eighteen hundred and seven-
- 17 ty-one. So that the same shall read, when amended,
- 18 as follows:
- 19 Sect. 1. That in all cases in which lands in unin-
- 20 corporated places have been bid off under the provi-
- 21 sions of chapter six of the revised statutes of eighteen
- 22 hundred and fifty-seven and eighteen hundred and
- 23 seventy-one, and the purchase money has been paid
- 24 into the treasury of the state or county, and the pur-
- 25 chaser has failed to receive a valid and sufficient title
- 26 to said lands, the title thereto shall revert in the
- 27 owner of the fee prior to the forfeiture thereof, or in
- 28 any person claiming under him by deed or otherwise
- 29 upon payment to the treasurer of state or county for
- 30 the benefit of the purchaser, or any person claiming
- 31 under him, the amount of the purchase money above
- 32 named, and all taxes subsequently paid by said pur-
- 33 chaser, with twenty per cent. interest thereon from the
- 34 time of payment, and giving notice in writing, signed
- 35 by said treasurer, of said payment to the purchaser,

36 his legal representatives or any party claiming under 37 him, which notice may be served by any officer quali-38 fied to serve civil precepts, or by any other person 39 who shall make oath to said service, and a copy of said 40 notice, with proof of service, shall be returned into the 41 treasury of state or county. Upon payment of one dol-42 lar, the treasurer of state or county shall make and 43 deliver to the party making said payment, a certificate

- 44 thereof, and of the proof of service returned to him,45 which shall be conducive evidence of the facts therein
- 46 stated in court of law or equity in this state.

47 Sect. 2. This act shall apply only to cases of at48 tempted sales under the provisions of chapter six of the
49 revised statutes of eighteen hundred and fifty-seven
50 and eighteen hundred and seventy-one, and any oc51 cupant or tenant under such attempted sale, who has
52 made any improvement thereon, shall have the right to
53 recover the same as provided in chapter ninety-three
54 of the revised statutes, and said lands shall be holden
