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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVES relating to an inter-state tax association.

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*Resolved,* That Maine recognizes the benefit that may  
2 be derived from an inter-state tax association, to be  
3 formed by delegates from different states, to devise  
4 and propose uniform rules of inter-state taxation on  
5 all property and business specifically involving differ-  
6 ent state jurisdictions ; and is ready to co-operate in  
7 the necessary measures to create and organize such an  
8 association.

*Resolved,* That the governor be and hereby is author-  
2 ized to appoint one or more delegates to represent  
3 Maine in an inter-state tax association, whenever it  
4 can be formed by the concurrence of such a number of  
5 other states as he shall regard sufficient to give the  
6 association the requisite element of efficiency ; and he  
7 is requested to open a correspondence with the execu-  
8 tives of other states, to the end that such an association

9 may be created and organized at an early day ; the  
10 compensation of such delegates to be determined by  
11 the governor and council, who shall draw their warrant  
12 therefor payable from any money in the treasury not  
13 otherwise appropriated.
