STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section forty-four of chapter eleven of the revised statutes, relating to school district taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section forty-four of chapter eleven of 2 the revised statutes, is hereby amended, by striking 3 out the word " thirty," in the fourth line of said sec- 4 tion, and inserting in the place thereof, the word 5 " sixty," so that said section, as amended, shall read 6 as follows :

7 "Sect. 44. When a district votes to raise money for 8 any legal purpose, its clerk shall forthwith, or within 9 the time prescribed by the district, certify the amount 10 thereof to the assessors of the town, and the time 11 when raised ; and within sixty days after receiving

12 such certificate, they shall assess it, as they do town
13 taxes, on the polls and estates of the residents and
14 owners in the district at the time of raising said money,
15 whether whole in their town or not, and on the non-
16 resident real estate in the district. They shall then
17 make their warrant in due form of law, directed to
18 any of their town, or of the district if any, if not to
19 a constable, authorizing and requiring him to levy and
20 collect such tax, and pay it, within the time limited
21 in the warrant, to the town treasurer ; and they shall
22 give a certificate of the assessment to such treasurer,
23 and may abate such taxes as in the case of town
24 taxes.”

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved
2 by the governor.
