STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT in relation to the assessment of school district
taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In the assessment of school district
2 taxes, the assessors may assess on the polls and estate
3 of the owners and residents in the district, such sum
4 over and above the sum committed to them to assess,
5 and not exceeding five per centum thereof, as a frac-
6 tional division thereof renders necessary, and certify
7 that fact to the town treasurer.

SECT. 2. The expense of assessing and collecting
2 any school district tax shall be paid by the district,
3 and the treasurer of the town shall pay said expenses

4 out of money of the district, upon the order of the
5 selectmen of the town.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
