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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

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AN ACT to amend chapter eighteen of the revised statutes, relating to ways in unincorporated places.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section thirty-five of the eighteenth chapter of the revised statutes, is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. Section thirty-six of the same chapter is hereby amended, by inserting the word 'appellate,' before the word "court," in the first line of said section; and also, by inserting the words, 'as herein after provided,' after the word "court," in the first line, so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows :

Sect. 36. If the final decision of the commissioners, or the appellate court, as hereinafter provided,

10 is against the prayer of the petition, no new petition  
11 for the same road shall be entertained by the commis-  
12 sioners for one year thereafter.
