STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-nine of chapter forty of
the revised statutes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. That section thirty-nine of chapter forty
2 is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said
3 section, and inserting the following words in place
4 thereof, so that said section as amended, shall read as
5 follows :

6 *Sect. 39.* Any person who shall have in his pos-
7 session, any fresh salmon, between the fifth day of
8 September of any year and the first day of April fol-
9 lowing, or any fresh land-locked salmon or trout, be-
10 tween the fifth day of October and the first day of
11 January following, having received the same by gift,

12 purchase, or otherwise, shall be liable to the penalties
13 of the preceding section.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent
2 herewith, are hereby repealed.
