STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to regulate and establish the compensation of
the examiner of banks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The examiner of banks, for his services, shall
2 be entitled to the following compensation, which shall
3 be in full for his official duties and expenses, viz. : For
4 the examination of each bank, as required by law, fifteen
5 dollars, and for making his annual report to the gov-
6 ernor and council, and preparing the forms for the re-
7 turns of the trustees and treasurers of the savings
8 banks, one hundred dollars, and the governor and
9 council shall audit his account, and draw a warrant on
10 the treasury, from time to time, for the amount found
11 due him.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with this act, are hereby repealed, and this act shall
3 take effect when approved by the governor.
