STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section five of chapter seventy-seven of the revised statutes relative to the equity powers of the supreme judicial court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section five of chapter seventy-seven of
- 2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding the
- 3 following specification:
- 4 Tenth. And shall have full equity jurisdiction, ac-
- 5 cording to the usage and practice of courts of equity,
- 6 in all other cases where there is not a plain, adequate
- 7 and complete remedy at law.
 - SECT 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
