STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT additional to chapter eighty-two of the revised
statutes relating to proceedings in court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In all civil actions the writ may be
2 amended by inserting additional plaintiffs, or by strik-
3 ing out one or more plaintiffs where there are two or
4 more, and the court may impose reasonable terms.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
