
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT to amend section three of chapter one hundred and forty-two of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, relating to fires.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section three of chapter one hundred and forty-two

- 2 of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-
- 3 three, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:
- 4 Sect. 3. The fees of the officer shall be the same
- 5 as prescribed for the coroner in cases of inquest upon
- 6 dead bodies, and the fees of the jurors shall be two
- 7 dollars per day, for each juror, for every day neces-
- 8 sarily employed in said inquest, with travelling fees
- 9 the same as witnesses in court.
