STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FOUR.

AN ACT additional to section eighty-six of chapter three
hundred and seven of the public laws of eighteen hun-
dred and sixty-five, relating to armories for military
companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section eighty-six of the public laws of the year
2 eighteen hundred and sixty-five, is hereby amended,
3 by adding to said section the following :

4 “And a reasonable compensation for rent of any such
5 armory or place of deposit, not exceeding the sum of
6 one hundred dollars per annum, may be allowed to the
7 town or city so furnishing such armory or place of de-
8 posit, and paid from the state treasury.”
