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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
SEVENTY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and thirteen of  
the revised statutes.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section twenty-one of chapter one hun-  
2 dred and thirteen of the revised statutes, is hereby  
3 amended, by striking out the words "twenty-four"  
4 in the second line, and inserting therein the words  
5 "twenty-six and the following sections," so that said  
6 section, as amended, shall read as follows :

7 *Sect. 21.* When so arrested, he may, without giv-  
8 ing bond, disclose as provided in section twenty-six  
9 and the following sections, by giving notice of the  
10 time and place appointed therefor, to the creditor or  
11 his attorney, at least twenty-four hours for every

12 twenty miles travel from his residence thereto. The  
13 debtor shall pay the officer for serving the notice and  
14 keeping him from the arrest to the disclosure, before  
15 he can be discharged.
