STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and forty-eight of chapter six of the revised statutes, relating to abatement of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one hundred and forty-eight of chapter six of 2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding in 3 the third line, after the word "collector," the words 4 "or treasurer"; and by striking out in the fifth line 5 after the word "taxes" the words "were committed," 6 and inserting the words "are to be paid to obtain the 7 abatement," and by inserting after the word "abate-8 ment" in the eighth line, the words " but no person 9 shall receive an abatement of more than ten per cent. 10 of the amount of tax assessed against him"; so that 11 the section as amended shall read as follows:

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At any meeting when they vote to raise a tax, a 13 town may agree on the abatement to be made to those 14 who voluntarily pay their taxes to the collector or 15 treasurer at certain periods, and the times within which 16 he is so entitled; and a notification of such votes, and 17 the time when such taxes are to be paid to obtain the 18 abatement shall be posted up by the treasurer in one 19 or more public places in his town, within seven days 20 after such commitment; and all who so pay their taxes 21 shall be entitled to such abatement; but no person shall 22 receive an abatement of more than ten per cent. of the 23 amount of tax assessed against him; and all taxes not 24 so paid, shall be collected by the collector or his 25 deputy, under the other provisions of this chapter.
