STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter forty-five, section one, of the revised statutes, in relation to interest.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter forty-five of the revised stat-2 utes is hereby amended by striking out the words "by 3 the year" in the second line of said section, and in-4 serting in place thereof the words "per annum"; also 5 by adding to said section the following words: "but 6 when any other rate of interest is stipulated for by any 7 written agreement or contract, such rate of interest 8 shall continue until such agreement or contract is fully 9 extinguished by payment or satisfaction, or is merged 10 into a judgment," so that said section as amended shall 11 read as follows:

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12 Sect. 1. In the absence of any agreement in writing 13 the legal rate of interest shall be six per cent. per an-14 num; but when any other rate of interest is stipulated 15 for by any written agreement or contract, such rate of 16 interest shall continue until such agreement or contract 17 is fully extinguished by payment or satisfaction, or is 18 merged into a judgment.
