STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section three of chapter one hundred and ninety-eight of public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, relating to disclosures of poor debtors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter one hundred and
2 ninety-eight of public laws of eighteen hundred and
3 seventy-four is hereby amended by inserting after the
4 word "state" in the fifth line the words "except such
5 island is connected with the main land by a bridge or
6 bridges," so that same as amended shall read as fol-
7 lows:

8 *Sect. 3.* In no case of disclosure by virtue of any of
9 the provisions of chapter one hundred and thirteen of
10 the revised statutes or acts amendatory thereof, shall

11 a creditor be cited or notified to attend for the purpose
12 of hearing a disclosure upon any island in this state,
13 except such island is connected with the main land by
14 a bridge or bridges, unless at the time of said disclos-
15 ure the debtor so disclosing resides upon such island,
16 and was arrested in the county where the same is situ-
17 ated. And all disclosures made in violation of this
18 section shall be void.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
