STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the city schools of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The superintending school committee of 2 the city of Bangor shall consist of not less than three 3 nor more than seven members, to be elected by the city 4 council.

SECT. 2. The city council may provide that a part 2 of said members shall hold for one year, a part for two 3 years, and a part for three years, in the first instance; 4 and in case they shall so provide, shall annually supply 5 the vacancy that exists in the board; in case they 6 shall not so provide, the tenure of office of the whole 7 board shall be for one year, and until others are qual-8 ified in their stead.

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SECT. 3. The city council may annually elect an 2 agent, whose duties shall be prescribed by the super-3 intending school committee.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect from date of its 2 approval.
