STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT amending an act entitled “ an act for the better
protection of lobsters in the State of Maine.”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. That section one, chapter two hundred
2 ten of the public laws of eighteen hundred seventy-
3 four, is hereby amended by striking out the words
4 “ catch, sell, or expose for sale,” in the first line, and
5 all after the third line of said section, so that said
6 section shall read: No person shall preserve within
7 the limits of the State of Maine any lobsters between
8 the first day of August and the first day of October of
9 each year.

SECT. 2. That section two of said chapter is hereby
2 amended by striking out the words “ caught, sold or

3 exposed for sale," so that said section shall read :
4 Any person violating any provision of the above sec-
5 tion shall be punished by a fine of ten dollars for
6 every such lobster so used as aforesaid, one half to go
7 to the person making the complaint, and one half to
8 the use of the town in which the offence is committed.
