STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the time for the location and completion of the Penobscot Bay and River Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Penobscot Bay and River Railroad

- 2 Company may have a further time of five years, from
- 3 and after the time fixed in the act incorporating said
- 4 company, for locating and filing the location of their
- 5 railroad; and also a further time of five years, from
- 6 and after the time fixed in said act, for the building
- 7 and completion of the said railroad, and all the powers
- 8 and privileges granted to said company shall continue
- 9 and be in force during said term of extension of time.

SECT. 2. Provided that said company shall not con-

- 2 struct any bridge across the Belfast bay or harbor at
- 3 any point below Lane's wharf, so called.
