RESOLVE in favor of Fernando F. Smith and Lewis C.
Smith.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and he is hereby
2 authorized and directed to convey by deed, to Fer-
3 nando F. Smith, lot numbered nine, range four, and
4 to Lewis C. Smith lot numbered nine, range five, in
5 Silver Ridge plantation, county of Aroostook, waiving
6 further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Smith boys have taken up their back lots off from the road, and have purchased of their father fifty acres each of lot No. 12, so as to live on the road, paying for the fifty acres in land from their back lots, so that the State gets an actual settler for each lot.
