## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Island Falls.

---

*Resolved,* That the lands belonging to the state which  
2 lay in the town of Island Falls, county of Aroostook,  
3 that is unfit for settlement, be sold by the land agent,  
6 and the proceeds be expended on roads and bridges in  
7 said town, under the direction of the land agent, or  
8 some person by him appointed to expend the same.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

---

Island Falls has a valuation of \$37,000 and a population of 182; and has a bridge to rebuild the coming season that will cost from \$2,500 to \$3,000. Said bridge is on the mail route leading from Sherman to Houlton, and without aid, the town cannot build it.
