STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of compiling and printing school laws.

Resolved, That the superintendent of common schools
2 be and hereby is instructed and empowered to cause
3 the laws of this state relating to common schools, to
4 include the laws passed the present session, relating
5 to the same, to be compiled, and five thousand copies
6 printed and distributed among the several cities, towns
7 and plantations in this state, the whole cost not to
8 exceed two hundred and fifty dollars.
